Qualifications for Delegate or Officer are: be a member in good standing of this local; be an AFGE member for the past year; not be a member in any labor organization not affiliated with the AFL-CIO; and not barred from holding office. A second for a nomination is not required. **Self nominations are permissible.**

Nominations also may be made in writing, and must be received by the election committee's Post Office Box 11812, Saint Paul, MN 55111-0812 no later than **May 12, 2017 (1300 hrs)** or delivered to the election committee before the close of nominations.

Candidates must accept nomination at the meeting or, if not in attendance, submit a written acceptance to the election committee, to be received by close of nominations. The member making the nomination has the responsibility of informing the nominee of his or her nomination. Placement on the ballot will be determined immediately following the nominations.

The election for Delegates will follow as soon as possible at the same meeting.

A runoff election for Delegate will be held immediately following the counting of the ballots. Installation will follow the conclusion of the election at the same meeting .

Each candidate for Delegate may have a reasonable number of observers, who are members, present throughout the election process, including the tally of ballots.

All protests to the election for Delegate must be in writing and received by the election committee prior to, during, or within ten days after the election. This election is governed by the AFGE Rules of Conduct for an Election, set forth in Appendix A of the AFGE National Constitution.

Following the close of Nominations for Officers, the election for Officers will be conducted by Official Mail Ballot. Official Mail Ballots will be mailed to each member of record on May 13, 2017 — to be returned no later than May 30, 2017 at the election committee's Post Office Box 11812, Saint Paul, MN 55111-0812.
